Dr. Tom Keller – PRAYER LETTER UPDATE – September 2011

Along the Way: Following a two-day trip to the countryside, visiting a nomadic family, I awake in my apartment with high fever, migraine headache, acute diarrhea and intestinal cramps. That night I go sleepless. The next day I chance a 15 minute walk to the local cafe. It's nearly lunch-time as I sit down to chat with a local. An hour later as I prepare to leave, unexpectedly, I realize my symptoms are gone! I can hardly believe it. I'm so relieved to have gotten through another such episode. *"Lord, that was a nasty one. Thank you."*



Ministry Update: While on summer break from classes, I had the opportunity to test my language skills by visiting a nomadic family (photos) for two days. Quite a "hands-on" lifestyle. Milking the goats? Well, that was fun too. But I got my fill by the end of the second day..



A couple of weeks later I traveled to my future village location. The photo with our missionary pastor and translator (photo) during a Sunday service. It was great to see the regulars again and enjoy the fellowship. When back in the capital city, my language tutor and new house-mate, "Aagii" (photo), a believer and college graduate who provides lots of language assistance throughout the week. He's been a great friend and blessing.



Answers to Prayer: God opened doors while in Khatgal to interview with the Director of the local hospital and governor's office. I am praying they will allow me to provide part-time dental treatment in our small village facility only 10 minutes walk from our ministry site. If favorable, they will provide the required work visa and license. I also received an special \$2000 donation from a supporting church which will be put toward dental items which the small hospital is not capable of supplying. This came at a time when the dental fund was depleted. Lastly, prayers for one language teacher, Bayarmaa, are being answered. Recently, we spent precious time together over lunch with another missionary couple. God's working in her heart is evident.

Prayer Requests: 1.) To be accepted for Work Visa and License to do dentistry in Khatgal 2.) That I would continue to improve my language skills 3.) That God would bring my teachers to saving faith in Jesus Christ
